
### **ADOPTION? FOSTER CARE?** WHAT IS IT? HOW CAN I HELP? **GET THE ANSWERS!**

### TIME CHANGE



Most of the United States begins Daylight Saving Time at 2:00 am on the second Sunday in March and reverts to standard time on the first Sunday in

November (The Energy Policy Act of 2005 extended Daylight Saving Time in the U.S. beginning in 2007). In the U.S., each time zone switches at a different time.

Many fire departments encourage people to change the batteries in their smoke detectors when they change their clocks because Daylight Saving Time provides a convenient reminder. More than 90 percent of homes in the United States have smoke detectors, but one-third are estimated to have dead or missing batteries.

Daylight Saving Time for 2010 begins March 14 and ends November 7.


